**Midwest Retailers Association Argues Against Unconstitutional Convenience

**TOLEDO, Ohio:** On Tuesday, June 24th, at 8 am, in the United States District Court, the Midwest Retailers Association will present its argument against the City of Toledo at a hearing for injunctive relief in the convenience store ordinance case.
